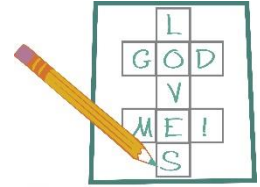
### May Item of the Month:

- Items for the **Brookline Food Pantry**

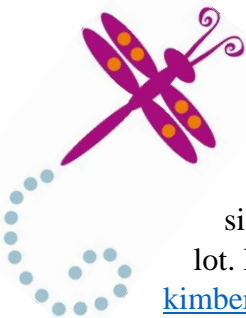
**Please Note: We are no longer collecting Greeting Cards and Stationery.** Our partner organization is not currently accepting these donations.
