Deacons' Fund 101

The Deacons' Fund is used primarily to purchase perishable food and grocery gift cards put in the Thanksgiving, Christmas, and Easter holiday food boxes distributed to local families in need and families in residence at Marguerite's Place. It has also been used to provide assistance to local families experiencing an emergency/crisis.

The Deacons' Fund is not funded as part of the church operating budget (what your "regular offerings" support). Funding is from individual donations, Holiday Concert bake sale proceeds, some proceeds from various church fundraisers and church groups, and payments for Deacons on duty at funerals. Per our Bylaws, it also receives the loose (cash) offerings on four Sundays each year: the first Sundays of January, Lent, July, and October, but since we've started hybrid worship services and many congregants now use auto-pay or online giving to submit their regular offering, cash offerings have gone down considerably.

If you are interested and able to contribute to this fund, starting in June, on Communion Sundays (the first Sunday of each month), a designated "Deacons' Fund" offering plate will be in the Narthex (it will not be passed during the Offertory). That offering plate will be exclusively for Deacons' Fund donations. If you donate by check, please make the check payable to the Congregational Church of Hollis with "Deacons' Fund" in the memo line. You can also contribute to the fund via our online giving at https://hollischurch.org/donations/.
