Dear Friends,

The Easter Season is a time of celebrating all the ways in which resurrection is possible in our lives. We can be in need of rising out of the depth of imprisonment, addiction, poverty, illness, and oppression—not just physically or materially, but also spiritually.

What keeps us locked up inside? What holds us back from the joy of life? What binds us, keeping us from the fullness of who God created us to be? During Eastertide this year (the eight weeks from Easter Sunday, March 31st, through Pentecost, May 19th), we're going to be hearing testimonies of courage, kindness, strength, and overcoming—Resurrection Stories—from people who have found "resurrection" in their lives. Perhaps they may inspire you to unlock your own rising up!

On April 21st, we look forward to worshiping with our sister church, Brookline Community Church, at 2 Main Street in Brookline. You may recall that the Brookline Community Church Band enhanced our worship service in January with their "electrified" tunes (i.e., guitars) and voices, and the Brookline congregation joined us in worship.


Birthday Box donations needed for Spring Community Service Project!

In April, we will again enjoy joint worship and celebration, this time with our choir and all of us joining them in their sacred space! **Please note: their services start at** *10 a.m.* We will be attempting to live-stream it on our usual YouTube channel—but please be patient and understanding if things don't go as smoothly as we'd like; it's good to depart from our comfort zones, but it can be a bit bumpy sometimes!

At noon on that same day, Jane Goodman—Executive Director of the Nashua Soup Kitchen and Shelter (NSKS), will meet in the Parkhurst Room with our newly-forming Ministry Team concerned with food & fuel (including the distribution of 50+ banana boxes of food several times annually). She'll share with us about the food and shelter insecurity needs of greater Nashua, as well as give us a clearer picture of how the various social service agencies are connected, creating the social safety net we help to support with our church's charitable giving, both financially and in terms of the physical support opportunities (volunteering time and effort, and various specific materials collections—e.g., coats, socks, underwear, hygiene kits, etc.—across the year). If you, or someone you love, have/has ever been in a moment of dire need and felt the life-line provided through these sorts of assistance, you'll recognize how it can feel like part of a resurrection experience! Anyone interested is welcome to come to that meeting! (12 noon, Sunday April 21st.)

Springtime blessings, my friends—may you be surprised and delighted across the month to come by the ways life emerges from dormant or dead places for you!







